WORLD CLASS MANUFACTURING (WCM)

Goal

Achieving comparable levels of supplier productivity to leading cost countries (measured by MVA per Rand of employee cost) thereby enabling localisation opportunities.

Programme

Four to six months of firm-level competitiveness upgrading, focusing on production optimisation; quality management systems; and shopfloor training

Beneficiary requirements:

- Existing Tier 1, 2 or 3 automotive component supplier
- B-BBEE compliant
- Financial contribution
